Session Dates for 2010

Classes run Monday-Saturday, morning, afternoon & evening.

Services for Individuals

New Participant Evaluation

The initial evaluation of any prospective participant involves an onsite office visit assessment as well as a brief mounted evaluation. All intake forms and evaluation are required before initial registration.

Therapeutic Riding

This is the core of our program. Combines participant's therapeutic, life and horsemanship goals. Groups, usually 3 to 5 riders, are based on age and ability.

Private Therapeutic Riding Lessons

Private lessons offer opportunities to work one on one to refine riding skills as well as therapeutic goals; private lessons are sometimes best for those who have difficulty in groups.

Time: 30 minutes

Hippo-therapy / Therapist Assisted Services

Licensed and certified therapists use the horse as a therapy tool to assist clients in reaching therapeutic goals. This non-traditional therapy is highly motivating.

Time: 30 minutes

*Therapists charge an additional \$45 /ride.

Camps for All Abilities

Day camps are for children of all abilities. Camps are theme-based and include equestrian, horsemanship, and crafts.
